Departments / PSU having experience in supply of miscellaneous electrical items are requested to submit their offer for the work detailed below.

- (i) **Net Banking** (any of the banks listed in the ICICI Bank Payment gateway) in case of payment through ICICI bank payment gateway.
- (ii) **RTGS / NEFT** through bank account in any bank. The EMD shall be deposited in favour of "New Town Kolkata Development Authority" payable at "Kolkata".

3) Both **Technical Bid** and **Financial Bid** are to be submitted concurrently duly digitally signed in the website <http://etender.wb.nic.in>

4) Tender documents may be downloaded from website and submission of Technical Bid and Financial Bid will be done as per Time Schedule stated.

5) The **FINANCIAL OFFER** of the prospective tenderer will be considered only if the **TECHNICAL BID** of the tenderer is found qualified by the 'Tender Evaluation Committee' formed by the authority of NKDA. The decision of the 'Tender Evaluation Committee' will be final and absolute in this respect. The list of Qualified Bidders will be displayed in the website.

- 7) The prospective bidders shall neither have abandoned any work nor any of their contract have been rescinded during the last 5 (five) years. Such abandonment or rescission will be considered as disqualification towards eligibility. (A declaration in this respect through affidavit has to be furnished by the prospective bidders without which the Technical Bid shall be treated as non-responsive.)
- 8) **Annual Turnover:** The organization should preferably have an average annual turnover of **Rs. 14 (fourteen) lakh** during three financial years. A certified document issued by a chartered accountant stating the average annual turnover of the bidder has to be submitted.
- 9) Joint Ventures will not be allowed as a credential.
- 10) The Manufacturer of reputed Brand having NABL accredited Lab with BIS certificate.
- 11) The OEM authorization letter of tender specified OEM at least of a brand should be included with a technical bid & OEM should have serviced by the bidder.
- 12) Minimum of 1 (One) no of tender specified OEM authorization require, in case of manufacturer not bidding directly.
- 13) A declaration of warrantee of Items as per tender from an OEM shall have to be submitted by the bidder through an AFFIDAVIT on Govt. Stamp paper, and distributor must be minimum five years old.
- 14) OEM have their own manufacturing unit for all items, necessary documents as mandatory to be submitted along with the technical bid & must be BIS certified.

15) Agency only having valid documents as per check list will upload the documents. Any act of uploading invalid documents to disturb the tendering process will be viewed administratively & legally.

16) A prospective bidder shall be allowed to participate in a particular job either in the capacity of individual or as a partner of a firm. If found to have applied severally in a single job, all his applications will be rejected for that job, without assigning any reason thereof.

17) No mobilization advance and secured advance will be allowed.

18) Security Deposit:

19) Retention money towards Security deposit @10% (2% EMD + 8% additional from bill) on gross payment will be deducted from the bill. EMD will be converted to Security Deposit for the successful bidder.

20) All materials required for the proposed work shall be of specified grade in conformity with relevant code of practice (latest revision) accordingly and shall be procured and supplied by the agency at their own cost including all taxes. If required by the Engineer-in-Charge, further testing from any Government approved Testing Laboratory shall have to be conducted by the agency at their own cost.

21) Payment schedule: - Payment will be made to the supplier within two months after the delivery of materials to the department, subject to inspection of the materials in good condition by the authority

22) There shall be no provision of Arbitration.

23) Bid shall remain valid for a period not less than 180 (*one hundred eighty*) days from the last date of submission of Financial Bid / Sealed Bid. If the bidder withdraws the bid during the validity period of bid, the earnest money as deposited will be forfeited forthwith without assigning any reason thereof.

24) The Quantity mentioned in BOQ is tentative, it may vary as per actual requirement according to the instruction of EIC.

26) The quantity of each individual items may vary in either side according to the actual requirement and/or subsequent augmentation of the site. Payment would be made on the basis of actual quantity supplied on either side without any price escalation.

27) On-going payments for work may be allowed to the executing agency as per existing rules and availability of fund subject to deduction of security deposit. Progressive payment may be made against the completed or partly completed item of works. Such interim payments, shall be made as running account bill (s), however, shall not construed to mean that the respective items / components have finally been approved and accepted by NKDA and the contractor shall not be absolved of his responsibility to set right any deficiency of such paid items / components at his/ their own cost, for rectifying all defects which are subsequently being noted or found.

28) Refund of Security Deposit (full) will be made after 05 (Five) years from the date of Completion of Work. Partial release to be made in the following manner: - 1st 3 years - NIL, 4th year – 30 % of the security deposit, 5th year - balance 70%.

29) Site of work and may be handed over to the agency phase wise. No claim in this regard will be entertained.

30) The supplier is liable to change all defective/Non-functional items within 5 years from the date of supply at his own cost.

31) Earnest Money Rs. 20,000.00 to be deposited online through e- tender portal payment gateway. Balance earnest money equivalent to 2% of the quoted rate (if any) to be deposited by the L1 bidder only.

32) The Bidder, at his own responsibility and risk is encouraged to visit and examine the site of works and its surroundings and obtain all information's that may be necessary for preparing the Bid and entering into a contract for the work as mentioned in the Notice Inviting Tender, before submitting offer with full satisfaction, the cost of visiting the site shall be at his own expense.

33) The intending Bidders shall clearly understand that whatever may be the outcome of the present invitation of Bids, no cost of Bidding shall be reimbursable by the Department. The tender accepting authority of NKDA, reserves the right to accept or reject any offer without assigning any reason whatsoever and is not liable for any cost that might have been incurred by any Tenderer at the stage of Bidding.

34) **Specification of materials:** - Specification of materials to be supplied is given in

Appendix "A." The bidders are requested to quote accordingly.

- 35) Failure to submit hard copy with the acceptance letter with the time period prescribed for this purpose may be construed as an attempt to disturb the tendering process and dealt with accordingly legally including black listing of the bidder.
- 36) Conditional / Incomplete tender will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- 37) The intending tenderers are required to quote the rate online.
- 38) During scrutiny, if it comes to the notice of the tender inviting authority that the credential or any other paper found incorrect / manufactured / fabricated, that bidder would not be allowed to participate in the tender and that application will be rejected without any prejudice.
- 39) The Superintending Engineer, NKDA reserves the right to cancel the N.I.T. due to unavoidable circumstances and no claim in this respect will be entertained.
- 40) If there be any objection regarding prequalifying the Agency that should be lodged online to the Tender inviting authority within 24 hrs from the date of publication of list of qualified agencies and beyond that time schedule no objection will be entertained by the Tender Evaluation Committee.
- 41) Before issuance of the WORK ORDER, the tender inviting authority may verify the credential and other documents of the lowest tenderer if found necessary. After verification if it is found that the documents submitted by the lowest tenderer is either manufactured or false in that case work order will not be issued in favour of the said Tenderer and his EMD will be forfeited followed by black-listing of his firm.
- 42) The successful Tenderer whose tender is accepted shall make formal agreement in WBF 2908 along with bid documents in triplicate will be available at office on payment of **Rs.1185/- (one thousand one hundred eighty five only)** per set, within 7 (seven) days from the date of issue of LOI cum acceptance order by Executive Engineer-E, New Town Kolkata Development Authority on payment of usual charges which is non-refundable under any circumstances and submit the same duly signed by him/them to this office. If the contractor fails to perform the formalities within the specified period the Tender is liable to be cancelled and the Earnest Money will be forfeited as per relevant clauses under memorandum of WBF 2908.
- 43) If any discrepancy arises between two similar clauses on different notification, the clause as stated in later notification will supersede former one in following sequence:

- 44) The intending Bidder are instructed to attend the prebid meeting to discuss the matter relates to any dispute/proposal with proper documents whatsoever. No dispute/proposal or objection

regarding technical specification would be entertained after the prebid meeting.

45) Escalation of Price on any ground and consequent cost overrun shall not be entertained under any circumstances. Rates should be quoted accordingly.

46) Tender Evaluation Committee (TEC)

Evaluation Committee constituted by the Competent Authority of NKDA will function as Evaluation Committee for selection of technically qualified contractors.

47) Opening of Technical Proposal:

Technical proposals will be opened by the Concerned Tender Inviting Authority or his authorized representative electronically from the website using their Digital Signature Certificate (DSC). Summary list of technically qualified tenderers will be uploaded online. During evaluation the committee may summon of the tenderers & seek clarification / information or original hard copy of any of the documents already submitted & if these are not produced within the stipulated time frame, their proposals will be liable for rejection.

- 48) No. price preference and other concession as per order no. 1110F dated: 10/02/2006 will be allowed.
- 49) Arbitration clause of WBF 2908 stands deleted, Settlement of disputes & arbitration shall be according to the 'Memorandum' for the modifications of clause relating to settlement of disputes under conditions of contract vide no. 8182-F(Y) dated: Kolkata, the 26th September, 2012 of Secretary to the Govt. of West Bengal, Finance Department, Audit Branch.

bidder. All the tender documents including N.I.T., Corrigendum & B.O.Q. will be the part of the contract documents. After receipt of Letter of Acceptance and work order, the successful bidder shall make formal agreement in BWF 2908 in triplicate which will be available at office on payment of **Rs.1185/- (one thousand one hundred eighty five only)** for each set, required cost shall be deposited by the supplier to the Canara Bank, Newtown Branch in favor of the NKDA within time limit to be set in the letter of acceptance or in work order.

1. (a) SMC loop box should be equipped with 4 way brass connector and din rail.
(b) Sizes of boxes are mentioned against particular items in BOQ.
2. (a) Monoblock submersible pump should be single phase (230 Volt).
(b) Capacity of pump is mentioned against particular items in BOQ.
3. (a) Pump's starter should be suitable for 230 Volt.
(b) Capacity of pump's stater is mentioned against particular items in BOQ.
4. LED lamp should be 230 Volt, 9-10 Watt, 5700-6000 K.
